Join us at the 2009 Concours D'Elegance of the Sports Car Club of the San Juan Islands, August 29 and 30, at the San Juan Vineyards on San Juan Island.

This is our 4th Concours and is our yearly main event. The Vineyard is about 2 miles out of Friday Harbor, on Roche Harbor Road. Lots of fine cars, beautiful scenery, good food, wine, and sunshine anticipated.

We start with an Island Tour on Saturday the 29th, on our winding scenic Island roads, with spectacular views. The tour will start at a time convenient to the Ferry schedule -yes, we time much of our activities to the ferry comings and goings. Then, Saturday evening, we have a set dinner at the Yacht Club. Sign-up will be required for the dinner.

On Sunday, the 30th, we have the Concours, with cars getting into place between 9AM and 10:30 AM.. The Concours will be open to the public at 11 AM. Judging will encompass a variety of classes. Last year had a great variety of cars including Porsche (the featured marque last year), Jaguar, Lotus, Morgan, MG, Ferrari, Ford, and many other beautiful classics, totaling about 75 cars.

There will be coffee and cake available during the event and lunch will be available in the pavilion. And of course the winery tasting/sales room will be open (no other alcohol on the grounds – per WA state law).

Awards will be presented between 2:30 and 3:00 PM, the event will end at 3:30.

The net proceeds go to charities. A car entrant fee of \$30 will be charged and spectators will be encouraged to give a charitable donation of \$10.

This year the theme is British Cars, but our show will include lots of other makes as you can see from 2008 results on our web-site. (See link below). Of course the show is for daily drivers as well as spic and span autos!
